

Hall Update

Things have been progressing over the summer break. The land from the Mental Health Trust enabling us to widen the driveway to the car park as part of the project is about to be transferred to us at a gross cost of under £500, *praise the Lord!* Our solicitor's fees have been kindly waived by James O'toole acting on our behalf. Our architects have been producing detailed design drawings in preparation for construction firms to tender for the project. Planning meetings involving input from wider members of the church family are being arranged this month to consider details for the kitchen, IT infrastructure, cleaning/storage facilities and environmental features etc. Pray for wisdom and clarity. A community leaflet has been drafted and is currently undergoing final editing. This is planned to be distributed before the season turns against us, probably with a simple survey to engage the people of the Parish with the project and encourage their support. Pray for the production of this leaflet, for many to step forward to help with its distribution and for it to release financial support from the community.
